

Kindergarten Supply List

Backpack

Backpacks should be regular sized no tiny backpacks, no wheels, big enough to hold binders, lunch boxes, jackets, water bottles, etc.

Pencil Box

One pair of fiskar scissors

Two packs of Ticonderoga pencils

Three 8 count box of crayons

Two glue sticks

One white 1 inch binder with clear plastic front

One white 1 ½ inch binder with clear plastic front

One pencil holder for binder (clear front, durable, and zipper)

One roll paper towels choose a size

One pack of copier paper

- A board game, puzzle, or activity that your student knows how to play for indoor recess (Legos, Candy Land, etc..)




