2121	Board Member Conflict of Interest	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adds new conflict of interest rules for board members as required by state law. • Includes a minor editorial change. • Updates the legal references. • Updates the footnotes.
2210	Duties of Officers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Updates language in D.6.
2400	Board Policies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adds a reference to policy waivers requested under policy 3430, School Improvement Plan, and adds policy 3430 to the legal references.
2410	Policy Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adds information from policies 2420, 2440, and 2450 to create a comprehensive policy addressing policy development and makes several editorial changes. • Updates cross references. • Updates footnotes.
2420	Adoption of Policies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rescinds this policy because the information has been added to policy 2410.
2430	Dissemination and Preservation of Policies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Updates and clarifies the language throughout the policy. • Updates the cross references.
2440	Policy Review and Evaluation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rescinds this policy because the information has been added to policy 2410.
2450	Suspension of Board Policies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rescinds this policy because the information has been added to policy 2410.
2600	Consultants to the Board	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adds a reference in the body of the policy and in the cross references to policy 6450, Purchase of Services.
3102	Online Instruction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revises Section B to clarify that schools may temporarily transition to remote instruction only if permitted by law. • Updates footnotes.
3430	School Improvement Plan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Removes Section C, which was an optional section, because it is our understanding that most schools are not dividing their school improvement plan into two parts. We have incorporated the information from Section C into Section B and changed the title of that section. Those provisions from old Section C remain optional. • Updates some language at the beginning of Section B. • Adds a provision in B.1 requiring that school improvement teams be familiar with state and local board requirements related to managing and using fiscal resources and comply with these requirements in developing and implementing school improvement plans. • Adds a reference to policy 3200, Selection of Instructional Materials, in B.3.c. • Adds a new B.3.d.viii to reference the school improvement team's option to modify system-wide instructional and curriculum guides as described in policy 3115, Curriculum and Instructional Guides. • Changes the language in B.4 to match the statutory definition of low-performing school.

4110	Immunization and Health Requirements for School Admission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adds the pneumococcal conjugate vaccine to the list of vaccines required for initial entry to school (applicable only to children entering school before age 5). (Required) Removes unnecessary language from Section B. Updates the footnotes. (Informational only)
4240/7312	Child Abuse and Related Threats to Child Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Moves information from the end of the policy to the introduction and to a new Section D. Adds a new Section H to address the new statutory requirement that child abuse and neglect information be provided to students in grades six through 12. Includes minor editorial changes. Updates the legal references. Updates the footnotes. (Informational only)
4260	Student Sex Offenders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clarifies the language in Section A. (Required) Removes a statement from Section A because the information is already addressed in Section B.
4302-R	Rules for Use of Seclusion and Restraint in Schools	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In accordance with U.S. Department of Education guidance, adds statements prohibiting, with limited exceptions, the unreasonable and/or discriminatory use of seclusion and restraint against students with disabilities and the use of prone restraint. Makes editorial changes to improve clarity.
4334/5035/7345	Use of Unmanned Aircraft (Drones)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Updates the information in subsection D.1 based on current FAA rules. (Required) Adds a requirement at D.2.e. Updates the information in D.2.h. Updates the legal references. Updates the footnotes. (Informational only)
