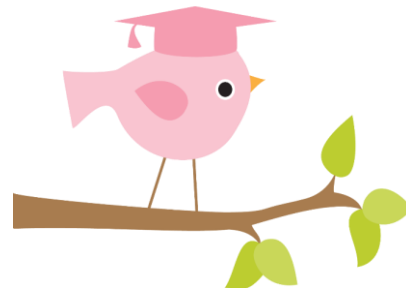


# Mars Hill Elementary May Newsletter
