Learning History of Farm Life:

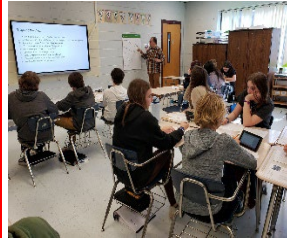

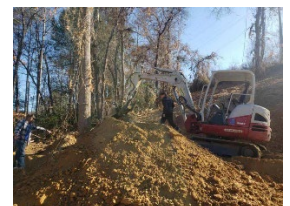
