## AB Tech President Plans for Re-opening:

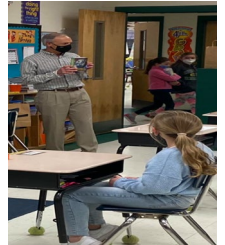
