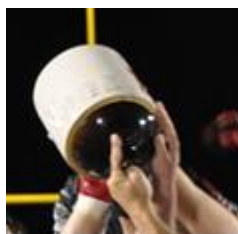
**Parking Improvements Made at MMS:** Madison County Division of the NC Department of Transportation provided gravel and spread it behind the gym at Madison Middle School. **K-5 District Leaders Plan Staff Development:** Kindergarten - Fifth grade district leaders spent time this week discussing newly released math data. Leaders were shown individual student performance as well as proficiency levels for the school and district. Madison County leaders are "Making It Happen" behind the scenes to provide the most effective instruction within our classrooms.



**School-Justice Partnership:** We are in the process of reviewing a partnership with several surrounding school districts and law enforcement agencies.
