## Educational Facts:

Compared to the 115 school districts in North Carolina, Madison County Schools are:

- ◇ Ranked **#1** in the state of NC for the 4-year Graduation Rate of **>95%**
- ◇ Ranked **3rd** in overall academic performance in the Western Region
- ◇ Ranked **13th** out of 115 school districts overall on academic performance

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Madison County Schools has no low performing schools under North Carolina accountability model

- ◇ Combined scores in all subject areas increased by 25.7 points in 2021-2022 compared to 2020-2021

### Social/Emotional Support

- ◇ Social/Emotional Learning Response to Covid-19 2022-2023 School Year
- ◇ Mental/Behavioral Health Providers assigned to each school.
- ◇ District staff including Teachers, Teacher Assistants, Counselors, Social Workers, School Nurses, SROs and Administrators are trained in Resiliency Training.
- ◇ Addition of support personnel, Counselors and Social Workers, assigned to each school.

### Interventionist K-8 Schools

- ◇ Provide targeted, skill specific, explicit instruction to small groups of students based on data analysis.
- ◇ Support staff in meeting the varied needs of students, including modeling of lessons and coaching.
- ◇ Flex-time to include push-in support, individual student support, help with assessing and progress monitoring

## How to Enroll Your Child:

State Law requires that a child must be five years old before August 31st in order to enter kindergarten for the 2022-2023 school year.

By Board policy, K-5 students are assigned to schools based on the attendance area in which they live. Kindergarten students and students new to Madison County Schools should contact their assigned school to set up a time to register. The school administration will advise you on documents to provide for registration.

- Birth Certificate
- Immunization Records
- Court Order for guardianship (if student living with someone other than the parent)
- Proof of residence

When entering the Madison County Schools from another district, parents should also take the following information to the school:

- Name, Telephone Number and Address of previous school attended
- Report Card or Grade Placement Information
