

## **MCS Safety Measures 2019-2020**

- School Resource Officers at each school
- School safety liaison position (Jeff Tweed)
- Strong relationship with the Madison County Sheriff's Department
- Strong relationship with the Madison County Department of Social Services
- Crisis Teams & plans in each of our schools
- Lockdown and safety drills are practiced
- Threat assessment training for administrators and SRO staff.
- Entrance gate at Madison High School and Madison Early College High School
- Panic button system that reports to monitoring center and Sheriff's Department in each building
- Updated intercom systems at each school
- Exploring IP phone system options with one-button emergency feature enabled on key administrative stations, sends alert announcements to all handsets, even those in use
- Web filtering and monitoring tools for all web traffic
- School security door systems and safety glass at each school
- Anonymous tip line for students and families
- Student social media filtering
- SwiftK12 alert call system w/emergency call feature dials multiple contacts per student
- Network firewall appliance prevents network intrusion that can compromise sensitive student and personnel records
- Anti-bullying web form allows anonymous reporting of suspected bullying
- Surveillance cameras in schools
- Stop Arm camera systems on 14 yellow buses (the State provides two per year)
- Cameras installed on 20 buses (have a quote to add to all 45 buses \$70,000)
- Two way radios on all buses
- A School Counselor assigned to each school
- A School Social Worker assigned to each school
- A School Nurse assigned to each school
- Certified First Responders throughout the school district
